SESSION I & II

Co-requisite English

If you need to take developmental English, and are eligible for ENA101 or ENC101, follow the 1st SEMESTER sequence shown on the left to satisfy developmental needs and the ENG101 Required Core, and then see other side for the second semester and beyond.

Co-requisite Math

If you need to take developmental Math, take the appropriate course before enrolling in MAT106.

1ST SEMESTER

IMPORTANT NOTE ON CANDIDACY

Key courses are used to determine a candidate's eligibility to enter the clinical phase of the program. Students may apply for candidacy every spring semester for consideration of acceptance into the clinical phase for the fall semester. During the clinical phase, students are trained to be Practical Nurses. The clinical phase is a one-year sequence in which students must attend full-time.

Key Courses: ENG101 (or ENA/ENC101), SSY101, MAT106, SCB203

Note: Although not a key course, you must take SCB204 *before* entering the clinical phase.
